## **CLUB CHAIRMAN'S REPORT FOR THE 2022 AGM**

#### **COVID-19 and Attendances**

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a huge effect on our club. A number of members have died; several have moved out of our area; and many have, simply, not returned to face-to-face bridge, often preferring to play online.

We suspended bridge at the club in March 2020 and did not restart until August 2021. During the break a limited number of online events were organised but we never fully evolved as an online bridge club. On our return, there were not sufficient players to make Fridays viable but Tuesday bridge continued with between 3 and 5 tables.

I expect that it will be reported at the AGM that our membership has reduced to around a third but with some members still inactive due to residual concerns over COVID-19 or other issues. The AGM will be critical to the future of the club and members must decide is which direction and in what form they wish it to go forward.

#### The Committee

This will be our first AGM since 2019. This marks my twelfth year as Chairman and Secretary before that. I have enjoyed the role very much but now feel I have served for long enough and will not be standing for election at the AGM. I would like to thank all the Committee members for their hard work and support over the last three years — we have continued with Committee meetings over Zoom, whenever possible. I understand that other Committee members are willing to continue in their respective roles except for Dave Norman.
